An image with a direct reference to reality has more **ICONICITY**



When it's more difficult to recognize something real, the image has less ICONICITY.



There are 2 big groups of images according the iconicity degree.

They have HIGH iconicity degree. The image elements can be recognized easily because they are mimetical representations of reality.







They have ZERO iconicity degree. It's difficult to identify the image as a direct representation of reality.

ABSTRACT IMAGES don't represent the real world directly, but they are an interpretation of reality: feelings and emotions.






Process of abstraction by PIET MONDRIAN with the idea of a TREE.










